All Admissions are strictly based on the merit, through NEET PG 2024 and the Counselling conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), duly constituted by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI, New Delhi.

ANNUAL TUITION FEE DETAILS

Please note that the confirmation of admission is possible only on payment of full fees for the first year. The fees for all three years will be the same for the entire duration of the programme. In other words, the same fee paid for the first year will have to be paid for the second and third years also. Students joining under NRI Quota have to pay fees only in **USD for all the three years.**

REFUND / DISCONTINUATION - POLICY

Withdrawal of candidacy shall be strictly according to guidelines prescribed by the MCC.

1	In case of re-allocation / resign after the first round & second round of counselling	Rs.75,000/- Processing fee will be deducted the remaining will be refunded to the same account from where the fees was transferred.
2	If any candidate resigns / withdraws after the third round of counselling.	No refund of tuition fee & other fees.
3	Penalty to be imposed if any candidate resigns/withdraws from the course resulting in rendering the seat vacant. or If any candidate resigns / withdraws after the last date of admission as prescribed by the DGHS/ NMC.	If the Candidate discontinues his/her course of study for any reason whatsoever after admission, the candidate with his/her parents / Guardian shall be liable to pay the whole fees for the entire course of study (remaining years also) before being formally released from the Deemed to be University and original certificates returned. A binding agreement to this effect will be signed by the candidate and his/her parents / Guardian.

- a) Request for cancellation through Email / Telephone/Mobile etc., will not be entertained.
- b) The maximum time taken to process and effect the transfer of refund of amount will be 5 working days.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

Separate hostels are available for male and female students and are comfortably furnished. All the students shall reside in the campus.

The rooms are fully furnished, with air-conditioning, hotwater geysers, student Wi-Fi and other amenities. The hostels feature common areas with reading halls, gym, theatre, playgrounds for football, hockey, cricket, volleyball, basketball & lawn tennis, etc.

STIPEND

The Medical Postgraduate programmes are conducted in accordance with the Regulations of the National Medical Commission. Selected candidates will be paid a consolidated stipend as per the Regulations.

5. Pharmacology 6. Pathology 7. Community Medicine

Note: Stipend will be paid only upon receiving the Annual Tuition Fees, Hostel & Other Fees *in toto* for the concerned academic year.

EXAMINATIONS

The student will be issued hall tickets for the University Examinations and allowed to appear for the examination only following the remittance of the fees, in full.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Medical Fitness

Upon admission, all students will undergo a mandatory medical fitness examination at our Hospitals to certify their fitness to undertake the course as per the regulations of the National Medical Commission.

This is done free of cost and the schedule will be informed to the students in due course of time.

Ragging

There is a strict zero tolerance policy with regard to ragging. Any student found indulging in ragging will be dealt with, in accordance with the rules in force prohibiting ragging and thus result in dismissal from the University as per the “National Medical Commission (Prevention and Prohibition of ragging in Medical College / Institutions) Regulations, 2021” and “UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009” (as amended).

Professionalism and Code of Conduct
