- 9. Internship Completion Certificate/Certificate from the Head of Institution or College that the candidate shall complete the Internship by 31st March, of the year of admission/ or if required the date as decided by the Competent Authority.

- 10.MBBS Course Completion/Conduct Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution or College.
- 11. Transfer Certificate from the Head of the Institution or College.
- 12.MBBS Degree Certificate / Provisional Certificate.
- 13. Recognition of College by MCI/NMC
- 14. Migration Certificate (If applicable) from the respective University.
- 15.Permanent Registration certificate issued by MCI/NMC or State Medical Council.
- 16.Ten (10) Passport size photograph same as affixed on the application form.
- 17. Proof of identity Aadhar
- 18. PAN Card
- 19. The candidate should also bring the following certificates, if applicable:
 - a. SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the format as specified in the Information Bulletin) and should be in English or Hindi language. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate. The translated certificate must be certified by a Gazetted Officer.
 - b. EWS Certificate as per the Central Govt. Norms (in the format as specified in the Information Bulletin) and should be in English or Hindi language. The translated certificate must be certified by a Gazetted Officer
 - c. OBC certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the Central List of OBC. The OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer. The OBC certificate must be in the format as mentioned in the prospectus. The translated certificate must be certified by a Gazetted Officer.
 - d. Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016 and NMC Norms. No other certificate, issued by any

other Authorities/ Hospital will be entertained. The format of Certificate of Disability is annexed (1, 2) in the Information Bulletin.

• The physical verification of the documents will be done by the respective college authorities and MCC has no role to play in the same. However, it is once again clarified that, the allotment made by MCC in any of the rounds is purely provisional subject to physical verification of documents of the candidate by the allotted college authorities.

Additional documents/ Certificates to be submitted by students allotted under NRI category:

The eligible Indian National Candidates wanting to get converted to sponsored NRI category will have to submit the following documents as and when the same are called for by the MCC:

- Affidavit of the person who is NRI and the sponsorer
- Documents claiming that the sponsorer is an NRI (Passport, Visa of the sponsorer).
- Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No. 689/2017- Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. Dated 22-08-2017.
- Affidavit from the sponsorer that he/ she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate duly notarized.
- Embassy Certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate).

Important Note:

- 1. The Candidates who have been allotted a seat through NEET PG Counselling by MCC are informed that they need to upload scanned copies of original documents to the MCC portal as per the dates mentioned in the schedule published by MCC. Candidates without original certificates/ documents shall not be allowed to take admission.
- 2. Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/
 College/ University and come for admission with a certificate stating that "their original certificates are deposited with the Institute /College/ University" will not be allowed to take admission.
- 3. Allotment letter given by DGHS for admission is subject to fulfillment of all eligibility criteria prescribed by the NMC and Medical fitness of the candidates. Those who do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and not found medically fit will not be admitted to the course of study to which they are allotted by the DGHS.

General Information for Candidates:

- 1. If a candidate fails to report on the date and time specified by MCC of DGHS in the allotment order along with the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee by Demand Draft/Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS with UTR No. on the day of admission, he/she will not be permitted to proceed with the admission process. The vacancy arising there from will be duly notified to the MCC of DGHS.
- 2. If any candidate withdraws from the course of study in which he/she was admitted, after the expiry of the cut-off date prescribed by MCC of DGHS for admission to that course of study or in mid-term or at any point during their time of study and the seat is rendered vacant, the fee paid till then will be forfeited and the student will also be required to remit the "entire course fee" for the remaining years of the course period.
- 3. Students will be governed by all the University rules including rules for refund of fee, disciplinary rules, hostel rules and UGC/NMC Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging etc. At the time of admission, candidates should sign declaration/undertaking declaring that they shall abide by all the rules and regulations of the University including and not limited to anti-ragging Regulations of the UGC/NMC and observe good conduct and behavior.
- 4. All disputes arising in the interpretation and implementation of the provisions listed above will be referred to the Vice-Chancellor of SRM Institute of Science and Technology (Deemed to be University) and the Vice-Chancellor's decision shall be final and binding.
