**ALLOTMENT/ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL**  
**COURSES-2024**

**Re-opening of application submission facility following lowering**  
**of the minimum qualifying percentile**

The NEET-PG-2024 minimum qualifying percentiles have been lowered as given below by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare as per Notice No. U.12021/05/2024-MEC dated 04.01.2025.

- General Category/EWS- 15 percentile and above will be eligible to participate in counselling
- SC/ST/OBC/PwD category- 10 percentile and above will be eligible to participate in counselling.

In order to enable the newly qualified candidates to participate in the remaining phases of the allotment process, the online application submission facility for PG Medical-2024 courses in Government, Self-financing Medical Colleges, and Regional Cancer Centre in Kerala, has been reopened and will remain open till **08.01.2025, 03:00 PM**. In this phase of online application submission, only those candidates who have freshly qualified as per the revised qualification criteria will be able to submit the applications.

**The candidates should also satisfy all eligibility conditions as specified in Clause 4 of the prospectus. In-service candidates who are newly qualified as per the revised NEET-PG qualifying criteria shall also apply if they satisfy the eligibility conditions specified in Prospectus clause 6.6.12.**

**The candidates who have applied for the PG medical allotment course 2024 vide notification dated 30.09.2024, but were excluded from the merit list due to the failure to upload the relevant documents in the stipulated time to substantiate their claim, will not be allowed the category reservation, even though they submit relevant documents in this stage. Such candidates can participate in the allotment process as General Category only.**

Candidates submitting fresh applications with any community reservation claim and with a percentile not lower than the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile but lower than the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile, and candidates submitting fresh applications in the PwD category with a percentile not lower than the 45<sup>th</sup> percentile but lower than the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile will be considered as General Category Candidates only, even if they submit the required certificates and documents in proof of their claim.

Candidates can avail the application submission facility through the link **‘PG Medical 2024 – Re-Opening Online Application’** on the website **[www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in)**, and should complete the online submission of the application and upload the required documents within the deadline. Those candidates who are eligible for any reservation (including the claims for Minority or NRI quota in self-financing Medical Colleges) or fee concession should upload the required certificates from the authorities concerned and all other valid and relevant documents in support of the claim. Newly qualified candidates, who find a place in the rank list, can participate in the third phase allotment subject to the condition that none of the allotments/admissions carried out in the previous allotments is disturbed.

Allotment of seats from the rank list for all courses in Self Financing Medical colleges will be made in accordance with orders of the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India /Hon’ble High Court of Kerala or the orders of the Government of Kerala/Government of India or as per the law in existence at the time of the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

Notification regarding option registration for third phase allotment will be issued later.
